There are approximately 190 Diocesan Priests, 59 priests over the age of 75, 65 priests aged between 65 and 75, 42 between 50-65, and only 24 priests under the age of 50!! As you can see the work of the Johnson Clergy Association is going to be vital in future years. Last year the fund gave grants totalling over £375,000. The annual collection raised £44,191.
